Pre-surgery preparation

- ~ Strengthening exercises
- ~ Home preparations
- ~ Infection prevention

Surgery

- ~ Explanation of knee and hip replacement procedures
- ~ Surgical safety
- ~ Pain management

Post-surgery and recovery

- ~ Prevention of complications
- ~ Fall prevention
- ~ Physical and occupational therapy
- ~ Rehabilitation needs
- ~ Home medical equipment needs

Classes are held the second Tuesday and fourth Wednesday of each month.
