

Gonorrhea and Chlamydia testing for Throat and Rectal Specimens



St. Luke's laboratory can now perform in-house testing on throat and rectal specimens for *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* and *Chlamydia trachomatis* using nucleic acid amplification (PCR) testing.

Throat and rectal swabs must be collected using the Aptima Multitest Swab Specimen collection tubes (orange tubes).
