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## TARGET AUDIENCE

This conference is most relevant for healthcare providers involved in the care of patients with a time critical diagnosis. This includes, but is not limited to, physicians, advanced practice clinicians, nurses, respiratory therapists and emergency medical personnel.

## OBJECTIVES
