If you want a caddy, please call the Pro Shop (218.525.1970) to make these arrangements. Spikeless golf shoes or tennis shoes are required. Golf shirts with collars are the required dress code.

Golf groups are comprised of both four-somes & five-somes. Groups with five players can either have three carts or a player can volunteer to walk with his/her bag attached to one of the carts. **For the safety of all and the liability of both St. Luke's Foundation and Northland Country Club, riding on the back of a golf cart is prohibited. No outside beverages/coolers are allowed at Northland.**

The staff of Northland Country Club will do everything they can to keep golfers aware of inclement weather. The course has a lighting detection system, but does not have an automatic siren. NCC will alert players to a suspension of play by sounding an air horn in various places throughout the golf course. Players at that time should immediately return to the clubhouse for their safety. **Continuing play after the horn has been sounded is not permissible.** If the golf event is canceled because of weather prior to playing 12 holes/average pace of course, each golfer will receive a rain check to be used on a weekday. RULES OF PLAY

USGA Rules shall govern all play.

Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and lines.

Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes and lines.

Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes.

Ground Under Repair is defined by white lines.

Men will play from the WHITE tees.

Women will play from the RED tees.

SCRAMBLE RULES

Each player tees off on each hole. Players will pick the best shot and all players play their second shots from that location. This process will repeat until the ball is holed.

Each team member may place the ball within one (1) club length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole and in the same condition as the original shot (rough, fairway, bunker, etc). When on the putting green, balls must remain within one scorecard width of the original location. When putting, once any ball is holed out, no further strokes count. The team is cautioned not to make “tap in” putts until all members have had the opportunity to attempt the team’s original putt.

MAXIMUM TWO PUTTS PER HOLE • HIGH SCORE PER HOLE = BOGEY
